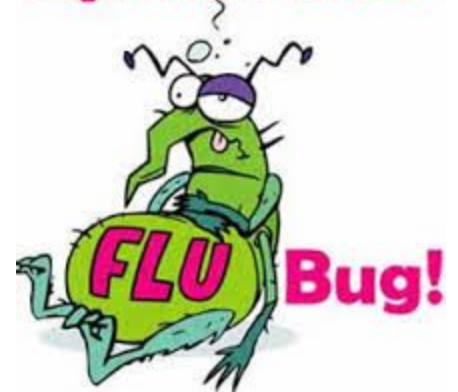
Please ensure to get your yearly flu shot as it is your best protection against seasonal influenza. You can get your flu shot at your doctor's office or local pharmacies.

The choir members are orphaned and impoverished children aged 8 to 18 who are being raised by Pastor Francis Daniel Mutibwa and his wife Winifred Tumu Mutibwa of Kingdom Child Project. They represent hundreds of thousands of children in Uganda and millions more in the rest of Africa who have been orphaned due to the effects of AIDS, civil wars and under-developed social systems. Their messages are heartfelt and heartbreaking but also inspirational and motivational.
